WORKSHOP INFORMATION

WORKSHOPS: 10 am - Noon and 1 pm – 3 pm (please arrive 15 to 30 minutes early for registration)
Lunch at noon will be provided by the Stonefly Maidens Fly Fishing Club

LOCATION: Blue Lake Regional Park, Fairview, OR

COST: \$50 - One workshop (morning OR afternoon)
\$75 - Two workshops (1 morning AND 1 afternoon session) or
\$125 for 1 custom workshop and 1 other workshop.

Note: The workshops will occur rain or shine. This is a fundraiser, no refunds. Pets are not allowed in Blue Lake Park. Space is limited and workshops will be assigned on a first-come/first-serve basis. Register early to reserve your selection. If you register for a workshop that is full, you will be notified.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

- **BEGINNING FLY CASTING:** Learn how to get started casting including casting mechanics, the roll cast and overhand cast (pick-up & lay-down).
- **BEYOND THE BASICS:** Fine tune your casting with a focus on mastering the casting mechanics of a straight line path, stroke length, arc, trajectory and tempo. This is a great class for those looking for a refresher on casting or those who have taken the beginner class.
- **ACCURACY:** Improve your accuracy by learning better loop control and line speed.
- **PRESENTATION:** Improve your presentations by learning curve casts, reach casts, and slack line casts.
- **DISTANCE:** Learn how to cast farther with less effort. Shooting line and single and double haul will be covered.
- **SINGLE HAND SPEY CASTING:** Add a new dimension to your fly fishing by learning how to spey cast with a single hand rod.
- **2 HAND SPEY CASTING:** Introduction to spey casting with a two-handed rod. Equipment is available for use.
- **CUSTOM:** Schedule a custom session with an instructor and tailor your workshop for your special interests. Class may consist of 1 to 4 people.
