he year 2019 has been our best yet, ur 16th helping men with cancer, with 32 Retreats completed, serving over 350 men in 21 states and New Zealand. We added new Retreats in North Carolina and Maine, and a second in Arkansas, and have now served over 3.650 men! We've added over 100 new volunteers, including a dozen new State Coordinators and several new Retreat Facilitators, and in 2020, we're looking to grow in Australia, California, New England (and perhaps Old England as well). Reel Recovery is thriving!

As I write this during Thanksgiving week, I keep reading over and over a letter we received from David, a 2019 Arkansas participant.

He not only gives "thanks" but so poetically defines what "giving" means at Reel Recovery.

On Page 2 we salute the 41 volunteer State Coordinators who are exemplars of this spirit of giving. Working throughout the year, they lead over 800 local volunteers to create a community of giving; raising funds, engaging their communities and providing life-changing experiences for our Retreat participants.
